

Amendments submitted by Teija Tiilikainen and Antti Peltomäki 17 February 2003

[Article 13: The coordination of economic policies (deleted)]

Commentary:

For reasons of consistency and clarity, the overarching aim of the reform should be to place all areas of Union action – with the exception of common foreign and security policy - in the three basic categories of competence. As no sufficient grounds have been put forward for the introduction of a separate provision on the coordination of economic policies, the proposed Article 13 ought to be deleted. The coordination of economic policies should be retained as an area for supporting action (Article 15).
