2. In the specific cases provided for by the Constitution, European laws and European framework laws shall be adopted by the Council **on a proposal from the Commission and after consultation with the European parliament.**

Explanation (if any): In spite of the fact that this paragraph concerns only the exceptions to the general rule and the decision-taking body is the Council, it would be more appropriate and clear to mention also the right of initiative of the Commission and the fact that the Parliament is consulted. This procedure could not be an alternative to the general procedure for adoption of legislative acts because the exceptions will be expressly specified in Part Two.
