<p><u>Article 27: Delegated regulations</u></p> <p>1. European laws and European framework laws may delegate to the Commission the power to enact delegated regulations in order to supplement or amend certain non-essential elements of the law or framework law.</p> <p>The objectives, content, scope and duration of the delegation shall be explicitly defined in the laws and framework laws. A delegation may not cover the essential elements of an area. These shall be reserved for the law or framework law.</p> <p>2. The conditions of application to which the delegation is subject shall be explicitly determined in the law or framework law; they shall consist of one or more of the following possibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– the European Parliament and the Council may decide to revoke the delegation;– the delegated regulation may enter into force only if no objection has been expressed by the European Parliament or the Council within a period set by the law or framework law;– the provisions of the delegated regulation are to lapse after a period set by the law or framework law. They may be extended, on a proposal from the Commission, by decision of the European Parliament and of the Council. <p>For the purposes of the preceding paragraph, the European Parliament shall act by a majority of its members, and the Council by a qualified majority.</p>	<p><i>DELETE</i></p>
