Suggestion for amendment of Article 28:

Article 28: Implementing acts

1. Member States shall adopt all measures of national law necessary to implement the Union's legally binding acts.
2. Where uniform conditions for the implementation of the Union's binding acts are needed, those acts may confer implementing powers on the Commission or in specific cases and in the cases provided for in Article [CFSP], on the Council.
3. Implementing acts of the Union may be subject to control mechanisms which shall be consonant with principles and rules laid down in advance by **the Council acting unanimously on a proposal from the Commission and after obtaining the opinion of the European Parliament** ~~in accordance with the legislative procedure.~~¹
4. Implementing acts of the Union shall take the form of ~~European~~ EU implementing regulations or ~~European~~ EU implementing decisions.

¹ Corresponds to Article 202 EC. It is important to keep this procedure to ensure that the Council has influence over the control mechanism in areas where the European Parliament is not co-legislator.
