Unless the Constitution contains a specific stipulation, the institutions shall decide, in compliance with the procedures applicable, on the type of act to be adopted in each case, in accordance with the principle of proportionality set out in Article 8.</p> <p>2. European laws, European framework laws, European regulations and European decisions shall state the reasons on which they are based and shall refer to any proposals or opinions required by this Constitution.</p>	<p><u>Article 32: Principles for European Community laws and opinions</u></p> <p>1. Unless the <u>simplifying Treaty</u> contains a specific stipulation, the institutions shall decide, in compliance with the procedures applicable, <u>on whether a European Community law or a European Community opinion is more appropriate</u>, in accordance with the principle of proportionality set out in Article 8.</p> <p>2. European <u>Community</u> laws and <u>European Community opinions</u> shall state the reasons on which they are based and shall refer to any proposals or opinions required by this <u>simplifying Treaty</u>.</p>
