Article I-50: Protection of personal data

1. Delete

2. [A European law shall lay down the rules relating to the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union's Institutions, bodies and agencies, and by the Member States when carrying out activities which come under the scope of Union law, and the rules relating to the free movement of such data.

Compliance with these rules shall be subject to the control of an independent authority.]
