<u>Article 9: [Judicial control]</u> In exercising its competences regarding the provisions of Chapters 3 and 4 of this Title, the Court of Justice shall have no jurisdiction to review the validity or proportionality of operations carried out by the police or other law-enforcement services of a Member State or the exercise of the responsibilities incumbent upon Member States with regard to the maintenance of law and order and the safeguarding of internal security, where such action is a matter of national law.	<u>Article 9: [Judicial control]</u> <u>The Court of Justice shall exercise judicial control in the area of freedom, security and justice, including over action by Union bodies.</u> In exercising its competences regarding the provisions of Chapters 3 and 4 of this Title, the Court of Justice shall have no jurisdiction to review the validity or proportionality of operations carried out by the police or other law-enforcement services of a Member State or the exercise of the responsibilities incumbent upon Member States with regard to the maintenance of law and order and the safeguarding of internal security, where such action is a matter of national law.
Explanation: <u>The article should reflect that the jurisdiction of the Court is to be extended to the area of freedom, security and justice in line with recommendations of the Working Group. A final wording should be provided in the article describing the role of European Court of Justice.</u>
