### Article III-153 (ex Article 1)

1. ...

It shall ensure ~~the absence of internal border controls for persons~~ **the principle of free movement within the area allowing the crossing of internal borders at any given spot without any controls** and shall frame a common policy on asylum, immigration and external border control, based on solidarity between Member States, which is fair towards third-country nationals, including stateless persons.

#### **Explanation (if any) :**

The remarks of the Presidium state that the articles of the Constitution “will have no headings, the headings in square brackets are given simply as an aid to Convention members at this stage”. I think that the headings are indeed helpful and I am convinced that it is exactly one of our main goals to make the Constitution better readable and understandable for the public. Consequently, the public should be given at least the same help the experts apparently need or welcome. The headings therefore should not “disappear” in the final version.
