<p><b><u>Article 16: [Criminal procedure]</u></b></p> <p>In order to strengthen mutual trust between the competent authorities of Member States and to guarantee the effectiveness of common tools for police and judicial cooperation, the European Parliament and the Council, in accordance with the legislative procedure, may adopt laws and framework laws containing minimum rules concerning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the admissibility of evidence throughout the Union;</li><li>- the definition of the rights of individuals in criminal procedure in compliance with fundamental rights;</li><li>- the rights of victims of crime;</li><li>- other specific aspects of criminal procedure, which shall be identified in advance by the Council, acting unanimously after receiving the assent of the European Parliament.</li></ul>	<p><i>DELETE</i></p>
