<p><u>Article 21: [Cooperation with regard to internal security]</u></p> <p>1. The Union shall establish cooperation involving all the Member States' authorities with responsibility for internal security, including police, customs and other specialised services in relation to the prevention, detection and investigation of criminal offences.</p> <p>2. To this end, the European Parliament and the Council, in accordance with the legislative procedure, shall adopt laws and framework laws concerning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– the collection, storage, processing, analysis and exchange of relevant information;– the training and exchange of staff, equipment and research;– any other measure not referred to in the following paragraph, that encourages cooperation between the authorities referred to in this Article. <p>3. The Council may unanimously adopt laws and framework laws concerning operational cooperation between the authorities referred to in this Article.
