Chapter 4: Police cooperation

Article 21: Cooperation with regard to internal security

1. The Union shall establish cooperation involving all the Member States' authorities with responsibility for internal security, including police, customs and **civil protection authorities**.
~~other specialised services in relation to the prevention, detection and investigation of criminal offences.~~
 2. To this end, the European Parliament and the Council, in accordance with the legislative procedure, shall adopt **European** laws and **European** framework laws concerning:
 - the collection, storage, processing, analysis and exchange of relevant information;
 - the training and exchange of staff, equipment and research;
 - any other measure not referred to in the following paragraph, that encourages cooperation between the authorities referred to in this Article.
 3. The Council may unanimously adopt **European** laws and **European** framework laws concerning operational cooperation between the authorities referred to in this Article. It shall act after consulting the European Parliament.

Explanation (if any) :
