~~In application of the principle of solidarity, the Union shall mobilise all the instruments at its disposal, including military resources, to:~~

- ~~— prevent the terrorist threat;~~
- ~~— protect democratic institutions and the civilian population from any terrorist attack;~~
- ~~— assist a Member State in its territory at the request of its political authorities in the event of a terrorist attack.~~

In the face of threats which confront their common security, the Union and its member states shall act jointly in a spirit of solidarity if a Member State is the object of a terrorist attack or other disaster. The Union and its member states shall for these purposes make use of all resources available to them, including civilian and military capabilities in the framework of Article 30, in order to grant help and assistance at the request of the Member State concerned. This will give expression to the principle of the indivisibility of the security of the Member States of the Union.

The detailed rules for implementing this provision appear in Article X of Part Two, Title B, of the Constitution.

Explanation (if any) :

The proposed language reflects more precisely how the UK believes the commitment should be implemented.
